

Still Time To Join in the Wall of Honor Success!

The Alpine Veteran's Wall of Honor is still looking for a few good men and women – those who deserve recognition on one of East County's most admired and sacred monuments to our armed services heroes. Chairman Dan Foster said, "There is still time before our Memorial Day celebration to get your loved one's name on this wall of distinction and respect. The response to date has been tremendous and there's no reason for anybody to be left out."

"The time consuming part of the application process is obtaining the proof of service that is required," said Bob Jackson. "Many families already have the needed proof of service at home. If they don't, the veteran or next of kin can order a free copy, but it does take a few weeks."

Applications must be submitted with proof of service (a DD214 or equivalent) and a check for \$125 per tile, which covers costs. Family groups can be placed together if the orders are received at the same time. Please visit the website www.alpinewallofhonor.org for the forms to download and details on how to order proof of service.

Applications submitted will be processed as quickly as possible and every effort will be made to place the tile on the Wall of Honor in time for the May 28th community celebration of the one year anniversary of this highly valued and widely appreciated Wall of Honor for those who have sacrificed to keep America safe. Bob Jackson and his wife, Debbie, enjoy helping people with the process of properly honoring each veteran. "The process may take awhile, but it is the most rewarding, gratifying effort you can make – helping a family, a wife, a loved one get their beloved service member's name on this beautiful space for patriots."
